Dear Parent or Guardian:

At the end of the last school year, your child participated in a computer-based test as part of the Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) which includes the Smarter Balanced assessments for English language arts (ELA) and mathematics.

San Leandro Unified School District (SLUSD) views these assessments as one way to provide parents and teachers with information regarding student progress towards college and career readiness. SLUSD is using these scores as part of one of many measures to identify student strengths and needs, and will also use scores to continuously improve high-quality instruction.

Student score reports can now be accessed electronically through the Aeries Parent Portal. The report shows scores for ELA and mathematics. It includes an overall score for each subject and information about how well your child did in different areas. Students in grades four through eight who took the test in previous years will also see past scores so you can see your child's progress over time.

To access your student score report, follow these easy steps:

1. Sign in to your Aeries Parent Portal account

- 2. From the top bar menu click on Test Scores > State Test Scores Reports
