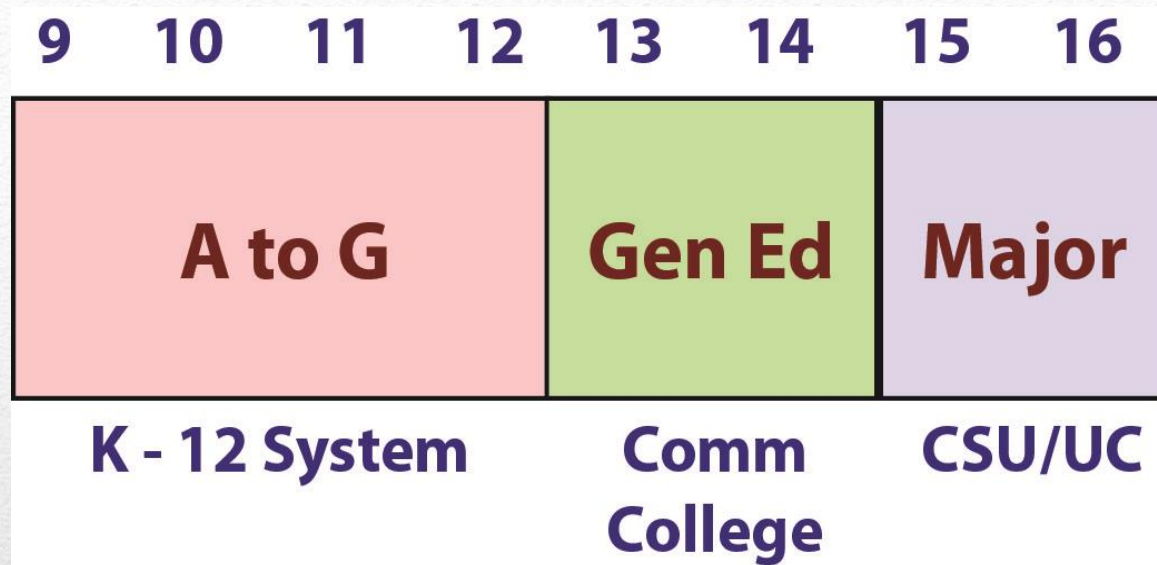

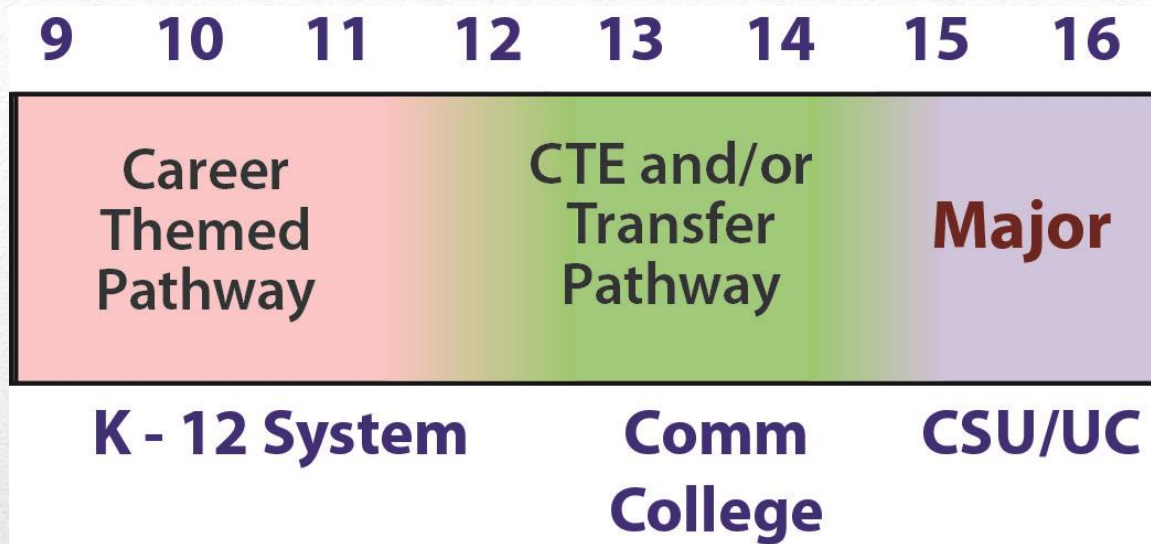
**Responsive, Personalized Learning

- Built when a HS diploma could get you a good job
 - Not aligned to real labor market demand
 - Lacks adequate support for transition to college
 - Students arrive and end up in remediation
 - It doesn't do enough to help students set goals
 - Does not reflect the new priorities of K12 education
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The 21st Century Changing World



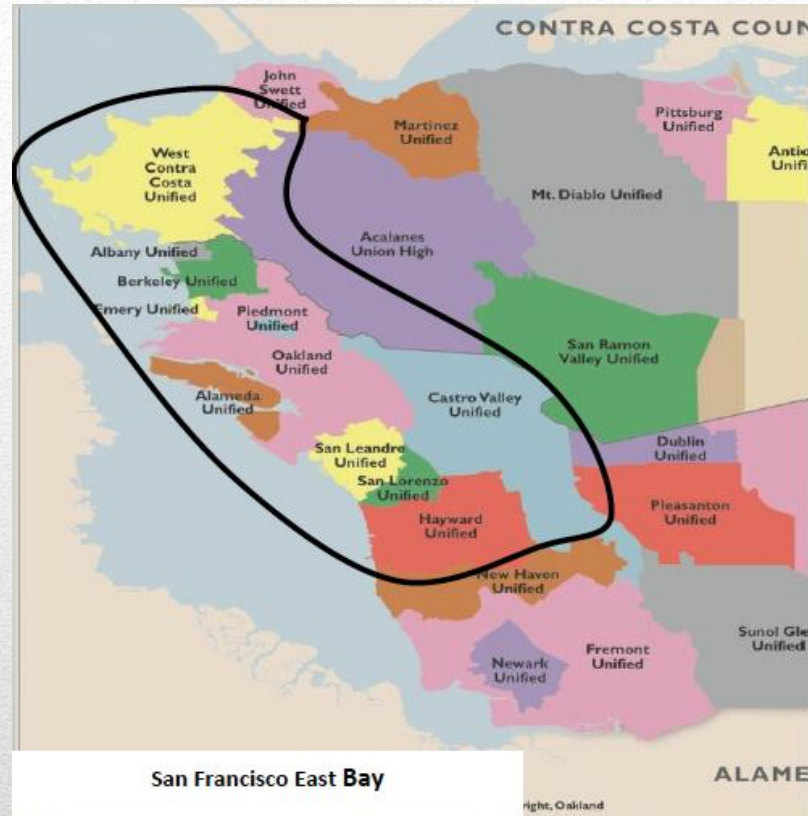
- Integrates academic and career themed curriculum
 - Strengthens opportunities for college credit in HS
 - Incorporates work and project based learning
 - Provides early matriculation and advising
 - Defines students as shared customers
 - Allows students to ID many options for work or continuing education

Career Pathways Trust

- **\$250 million available for one-time competitive grants for K-14 Career Pathways Programs**
 - **Regional partnerships of colleges, K12, and industry to create K14 pathway programs**
 - **Develop and integrate standards-based academics with a career-relevant, sequenced curriculum following industry-themed pathways that are aligned to high-need, high-growth, or emerging regional economic sectors**
 - **Establishes regional systems for engaging employers, strengthening work based learning, sharing data, measuring outcomes, concurrent/dual enrollment, and other issues**
 - **Builds or strengthens data integration across K12, colleges, and the workforce system**
